Service of Respondent No.6 is not complete. Respondent No.6 was impleaded as respondent in the writ petition because it was on his complaint that the benefit of bonus marks earlier given to the appellant was withdrawn. It is also stated that Respondent No.6 has otherwise got admission in the PG Course and the result of this appeal will not affect his admission.

All efforts shall be made to serve Dasti notice on Respondent No.6 by tomorrow. In addition, the appellant shall submit a copy of appeal along with annexures in the office of Respondent No.3 through whom Respondent No.6 shall be served.

Taking into consideration the submissions of learned counsel for the appellant that even though the appellant had actually served in the rural area for 750 days, the benefit of bonus marks has been denied only on the ground that such posting was



temporary and she was not granted incentives for service in rural area and that it being not in dispute on facts that appellant actually served the rural masses by remaining posted in the rural area PHCs, we are inclined to protect the appellant in the manner that the appellant shall be allowed to participate in the counseling scheduled tomorrow and while preparing the merit list, the appellant's candidature and choice of seat would be considered by including the bonus marks awardable for working in rural areas for 750 days. The participation and allotment of seat to the appellant as also admission of the appellant, however, shall be provisional and subject to the outcome of this appeal.

List this appeal for final hearing on 05.12.2022.
